Dear Parent / Carer,

I hope that you have had a restful summer break, and we look forward to welcoming your child back into school. Below is a reminder of our expectations around uniform, attitude and behaviour. Please take the time to read through this letter with your child to ensure a smooth and positive start to the new academic year.

Uniform suppliers

At this time of year, you may be looking to replace uniform items that your child has outgrown, or are no longer in a fit condition to wear to school. Our designated uniform suppliers are UNIFORM4KIDS, located at; 1103/05 Finchley Rd, NW11 0QB. If you need to visit the shop to ensure the correct sizing, you can book an appointment online at www.uniform4kids.com, or make an appointment via the telephone on 020 8209 0999.

Uniform expectations

A few reminders regarding hair, shoes, coats and bags. As part of our uniform policy all students are expected to wear the school bag, which can be purchased via our uniform supplier, other bags are not allowed. Coats must be plain black, without stripes, patches of colour or large motifs, and must be long enough to cover the blazer. Coats should not be leather, denim, suede, fur or PVC. School shoes should be plain black, flat, leather shoes. Boots, trainers, canvas and trainer styled shoes are not permitted. Our expectations regarding the PE uniform can also be found in the school planner, and purchased via our uniform suppliers, no other sports wear should be worn. Regarding haircuts, our policy remains the same. Students are not allowed undercuts, patterns or lines shaved into their hair or eyebrows. We do not allow skin fades or completely shaven hair, and we ask that hair is shaved to a minimum grade 2. Hair dyes, tints, and highlights that are an unnatural colour are not permitted. We do not allow hair to be dip dyed or any outlandish styles. As ever, we encourage you to discuss with us any questions you may have regarding uniform, so that all uniform, bags and hair styles are in keeping with our expectations.

Travelling to and from school

All students are required to be in school by 8.25am to ensure a punctual start to the school day. Students are not allowed to loiter in the local area before or after school, and if they are seen to do so they will be sanctioned as outlined in the school planner.
